

- **Asset** An item of property owned by a person.
- **Community** A group of people living in the same place or sharing attitudes or interests.
- **Croft** A small rented farm comprising a plot of arable land attached to a house and shared pasture.
- **Emigrate** To leave one's own country in order to settle permanently in another.
- **Enterprise** A business project or undertaking.
- **The Clearances** The eviction of many tenants in the Highlands and Islands, mainly between 1750-1860.
- **Feudalism** A medieval system of rule whereby the nobles were granted land by the King.
- **Inheritance** To pass property from one generation to another.
- **Parliament** A place where the highest laws are made.
- **Property** A thing belonging to someone.
- **Responsibilities** Duties that you are expected to do.
- **Rights** Freedoms we have protected by laws.
- **Reform** Make changes in something in order to improve it.
- **Sasine** An ancient ceremony of land exchange and the name for the records of land ownership in Scotland.
- **Sustainable** Means meeting our own needs without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs
- **Tenant** A person who occupies land or property rented from a landlord.
- **Trust** An arrangement whereby a group of people (trustees) hold property as its nominal owner for the good of one or more beneficiaries.
